Along with the Pandigital frame that we reviewed yesterday, we also got a chance to look at, and review the Pandigital Photo, Slide & Negative Converter scanner, and were extremely surprised and impressed with the product, which you as readers will see shortly.

We were told of the scanner that could do upto 4x6 pics, slides and negatives and immediately jumped to review it.

Opening the box, my first though was "bummer, they forgot the scanner." Well then I flipped open a couple more slots in the box and found this gadget that could fit in the palm of my hand; it was the scanner. (That is what we IT pros call and "eye d ten tee" error... aka, I-D-10-T aka IDIOT.

The box contained all that i needed to have to scan and preserve all past photographic memories, whether they were color and black and white photos, slides or negatives.

The great perk of this scanner, is that although it has a usb cable for scanner to pc hookup, there is no real reason for you to even NEED a pc to use this scanner. It comes with an SD card which all the images will be scanned to and saved on. You then take the SD card and put it in your pc's card reader, and you then have all your memories to do as you wish with them.

In fact, from unboxing it, to scanning my first photo, to viewing that photo and uploading it, took less than 5 minutes. That is amazing. In otherwords, show me a traditional scanner that can boast that, and you will be the first person to own ocean front property in Nebraska.

Once the power was plugged in and the SD card was inserted, it was time to scan. Scanning without a computer is new to the writer, but a welcomed change at that. With the shoebox of memories out of the closet, 12 pictures were selected, varying in color intensity size and age. A picture was simply put in and it was auto fed through the rest of the process. All scanned with ease and quickly at that. Each picture, even a full color 4x6 (40 year old) Polaroid scanned in less then 2 seconds each. The clarity of the pictures after scanning will depend on the actual quality of the picture being scanned. but none the less will leave you amazed and happy knowing you have now started
